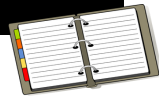

Today we have Julian Safina from Christians Against Poverty (CAP) speaking to us. CAP is a not for profit organisation that is passionate about releasing Kiwis from a life sentence of debt, poverty and its causes. It does this by partnering with churches, equipping members of local congregations to run a three-week course that focuses on teaching people how to budget, save and spend responsibly. Thousands have been set financially free through the work of CAP in NZ and the UK, and it has helped Churches to reach out to their community in a practical kingdom orientated way.

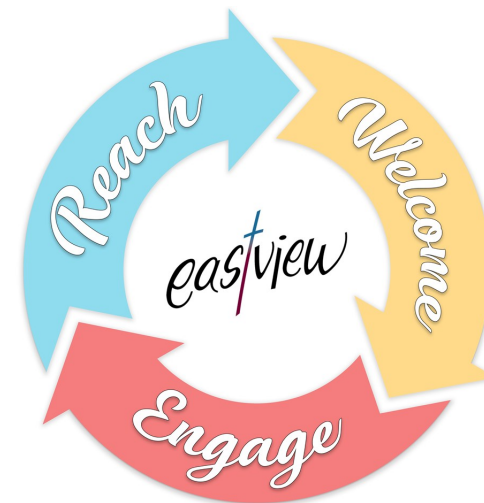
