School Holidays - Please pray for the youth and especially those who have come back from Ponui Island camp, that they would carry on having a renewed Godly spirit for the year ahead.

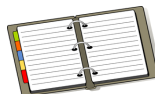

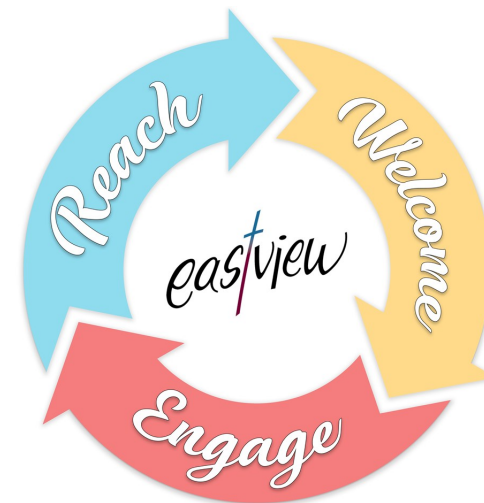
