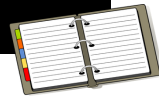

Good morning and a warm welcome to Eastview Baptist Church.

If you are visiting with us for the first time, a special welcome! We are a group of people endeavouring to follow Jesus Christ both together and in our daily lives.

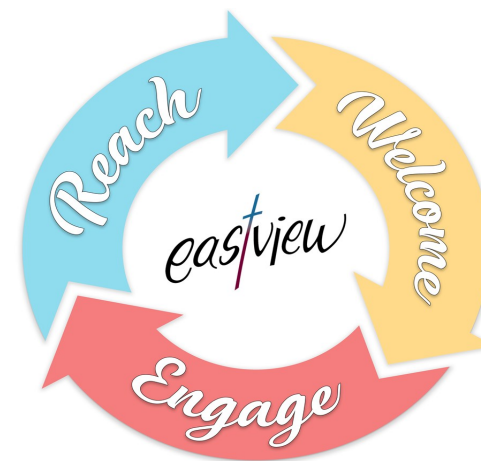
