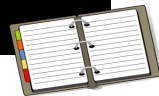

Kia ora and welcome to Eastview Baptist. We hope you enjoy your time with us this morning.

The Alpha course was first designed in 1977 by members of Holy Trinity Brompton in London. Since it first began it has spread across the globe with millions of people attending courses and coming to faith in Jesus Christ.

Over the years this course has changed and developed with the times and is now condensed into an interactive, well presented video series that usually occurs over 10 weeks and one retreat weekend away. Here at Eastview, we began running the Alpha course in term three of last year. At first we were a little nervous that we were not going to have many participants. 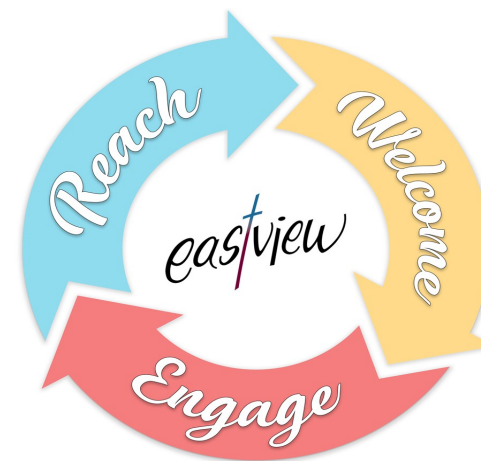
