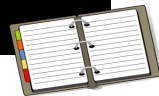

Pastor's Pen



Good morning and welcome to Eastview Baptist Church.

This week I have been pondering Eastview's mission statement "To know Christ and to share His love with others" and at the same time I have been reflecting on the crucifixion, as we draw near to Easter.

A cross is constructed of two pieces of wood, one vertical and one horizontal.

These could be said to represent two key aspects of our lives as we seek to follow Jesus Christ.

How is your relationship with Jesus Christ? Do you know Him, His Word, His encouragement in your life daily? That is the vertical aspect of the cross, our relationship with the living God.

How are your relationships with others? Have you tried talking to anyone about your faith in Christ recently? God calls us to reach out to others.

Once an expert in Old Testament Law approached Jesus and asked Him what the most important commandment was. Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:37-40

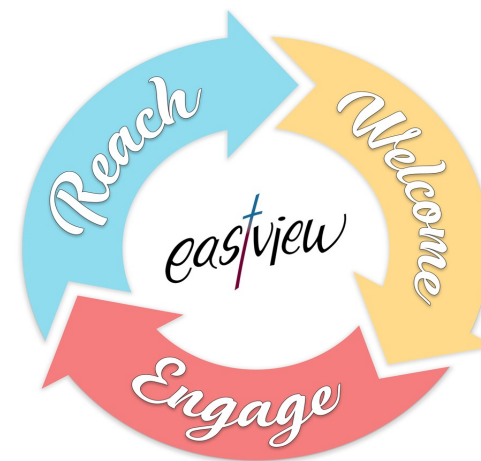
