Pastor's Pen

Good morning and welcome to Eastview Baptist Church!

One of my favourite books in the Bible is the book of Psalms. Earlier this year, we had a brief sermon series examining some Psalms from the point of view of Walter Brueggemann's Orientation – Disorientation – Reorientation.

Recently I was reading a book from the Carey Baptist College library and was excited to find a chapter outlining how praying the Psalms can help people recover well from trauma. That has proved true in my own life, so it was interesting to read a more academic treatment of the subject.

The author Samuel Thielman concludes, "The Psalms are the prayer book of the Bible, and there is ample precedent in the New Testament and the life of the church to indicate that, in Christ, we can make these prayers our own ... Praying the Psalms helps us increase our resilience and enhance our endurance as Christians, pointing out ways to take shelter in God, and to persist in our work for the everlasting kingdom described in Psalm 145:13."

How about adding a Psalm to your daily reading? It could strengthen your ability to follow God in this sometimes difficult world.
